Year 9 Marine Studies Modules:

Students electing Marine Studies in Year 9 will commence the Stage 6 accelerated program making them eligible to complete the HSC in Marine Studies in Year 11 if they choose to do so.

The course is instituted in biological and ecological principles with attention to marine resource management (marine biology, threats and conservation, ecosystems, ecotourism, recreation, preserving shipwrecks and ecological sustainable development). Marine Studies students learn to make informed decisions about their use of the marine environment. They are made aware of dangers and hazards associated with the marine environment and they learn the skills to make judgements on how to enjoy it safely. Marine Studies also provides students with the knowledge they need if they choose to study Marine Studies for their Higher School Certificate.
