**RETURNING TO SCHOOL** 

22 October 2021

Dear Parents and Caregivers

From 25 October, all other students will resume their normal onsite classes, online learning will cease and is not available as an option. All students are expected to return to school.

As a part of this process it is important to be aware of the following:

- all school loaned equipment is required to be returned to the front office to be signed back in for general use on site. This includes any text books, computers and dongles. This can happen at any time from now but is to be returned upon students' return to school.
- Masks are mandatory on school busses and on site while at school.
- Students cannot borrow equipment they must have their own pens, pencils etc required for their learning.
- The canteen will only be available for online purchases to be delivered to the students in their designated playground areas. This can be done through the school website. This will be reviewed to full functioning as soon as possible.
- Students are required to bring their own refillable drink bottle for water from the water fountains, bubblers are not to be used.
- Students will be expected to have with them and use their Yondr pouches.
- There will be movement around the school and playground restrictions for an indefinite period of time. This will be relayed to students when they return.
- Playground duty areas and movement around the school is displayed on the front office doors and near the library. Students will be given this information on Monday. Students need to move in one direction- up from the school through C, B and A block and from the top of the school through Science, TAS and CAPA blocks-moving only in one direction.
- Roll call will be:
  - Year 7 in the Quad near the office,
  - Year 8 in the quad near the canteen
  - Year9 on the basketball courts near the barn
  - Year 10 on the basketball courts near the studio
  - Year 11 in the hall
- The school uniform shop is under restrictions, please order online or book for an appointment.



As per Department guidelines, there will be some check-in assessments carried out upon return to school so student progress and improvement can be assessed and teaching programs developed to meet the needs of the students.
