CREATIVE AND PERFORMING ARTS PROGRAM (CAPA) Year 7 2026

Thank you for your interest in the Creative and Performing Arts Program at Narara Valley High School. Students participating in the Creative and Performing Arts Program undertake specialised development programs in their chosen CAPA area during school time as a reportable school subject. This is integrated with a full academic curriculum, which caters for the needs of the creative and performing arts students.

- Throughout the fortnightly cycle, students will receive a 4 x 1 hour sessions with specialised tutors focusing on skills in a range of Creative and Performing Arts areas
- Opportunities to audition in school-based and extra-curricular performance events

Placement in the program is dependent on:

- An ability, interest and potential in the nominated Creative and Performing Arts area/s.
- A recognisable commitment to school studies and academic performance.
- An excellent record of school conduct and attendance.
- Compliance with DoE and school enrolment policy.

Process:

- Complete a 2026 Creative and Performing Arts Expression of Interest form online. A paper form is attached for reference and can be used if electronic submission is not possible.

AUDITION INFORMATION

WHAT DO I PREPARE?

VOCAL

All students are to prepare an approximately 1 minute vocal solo to submit, with appropriate accompaniment if you wish.

DANCE:

All students are to prepare an approximately 1 minute solo dance item to submit. The solo dance can be in any style of Dance. Please aim to include some skills such as turns, jumps and balances.

DRAMA:

All students will be required to do perform a prepared piece of their own choice: (this could be a dramatic/comic monologue, piece of prose, a prepared story told in a dramatic way) approximately 1 minute duration.

INSTRUMENTAL: (For students already learning an instrument)

Instrumental audition: a prepared solo item on your instrument of approximately 1 minute in length, either with or without accompaniment.

VISUAL ARTS:

Submit a portfolio of 5 artworks you have completed. (Ensure your name and details are included).

SCHOOL REPRESENTATION:

Successful applicants will be expected to represent Narara Valley High School in performance events including Central Coast Schools Showcase, Youth in Performing Arts, Star Struck, Schools Spectacular, and a variety of school based and extracurricular CAPA activity for which they are selected. Each individual's commitments will be monitored and discussed with students and parents. It is compulsory that CAPA Program students perform to the best of their ability at representative events.

MEDICAL CONDITION:

Parents/guardians must inform the school if the student applying has any medical condition, physical disability or injury, which puts him/ her at risk when participating in the school's CAPA programs & activities.
